

EPA SMART GROWTH PROGRAM ASSISTANCE BY STATE

Smart Growth Leadership Institute (SGLI): Helps state and local elected, civic, and business leaders design and implement effective land use strategies to successfully leverage the coming growth.

National Vacant Properties Campaign: Provides information, resources, tools, and assistance to support vacant property revitalization efforts.

Local Government Commission's Emergency Responders Grant: Brings together emergency response officials, local government officials, transportation experts, and developers to engage in a problem-solving process to meet both the needs for emergency response and the design of smart growth streets.

Smart Growth Brownfields Grant: Helps communities remove barriers and incorporate smart growth into planning and/or redevelopment of brownfields.

ULI Regional Networks Grant: Grant to the Urban Land Institute to create and support regional alliance of diverse stakeholders to promote smart growth.

AMPO Partnerships: This project brought Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) and the EPA together to investigate how to apply smart growth principles to the transportation planning process.

Smart Growth INDEX Model: GIS model and software that measures different development factors to reach smart growth goals desired by a community.

Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Special Assistance: Provides technical assistance to communities that are facing barriers to smart growth.

Smart Growth Implementation Assistance (SGIA): Provides technical assistance to communities that are facing barriers to smart growth.

Governor's Institute on Community Design: Workshops with Governors and their staff to help states meet planning/development goals.
